The Episcopal Real Estate Agents Association FAQ'S

What is the Episcopal Realtors Association?

It is a group of real estate agents in the Diocese of California who share a common vision of giving back to God some measure of the abundance they experience in the work they do.

These people commit to gifting a referral fee or a portion of their commission on any transaction they carry out on behalf of a client connected to the Church. In addition, they may work pro bono for the Church directly, and they arrange to gift referral fees received from other agents who may be working on church-related transactions.

What are referral fees?

Realtors typically arrange for a referral fee to be paid to any agent who has sent them a client. These fees are usually between 20% and 30% of the brokerage fee earned by the agent handling the transaction.

At the close of an escrow, this 20-30% of the brokerage fee is sent to the referring agent or their office. These referral fees can be substantial.

The members of the Episcopal Real Estate Agents Association have agreed to help create these referral arrangements and to gift the resulting fees to whichever parish or ministry is selected.

By this means, they have taken a common business arrangement and given it a charitable purpose.
